To qualify for an Intermediate Driver License (IDL) at 16 or 17 students must have passed an approved driver training course, have an Instruction Permit for at least 6 months, and present parental certification stating you have at least 50 hours of supervised driving experience, including 10 hours at night – not have been issued a traffic ticket or do not have any traffic tickets pending at the time of application *not have been convicted of or found to have committed a traffic violation within the last six months before the application for the IDL. *Not have been convicted or found to have committed an offense involving the use of alcohol or drugs while you had an instruction permit. Once you receive an IDL, the following restrictions apply:

- 1. You may not drive between the hours of 1 a.m. and 5 a.m. unless accompanied by a parent, guardian, or a licensed driver who is at least 25 years of age.
- 2. For the first six months you may not drive any passenger under 20 who are not members of your immediate family.
- 3. For the remaining time, you may not drive more than three passengers who are under 20 who are not members of your immediate family.

Restrictions are automatically lifted when you've had IDL for one year – no automobile collision – no road traffic offence or violated any IDL restrictions. On your 18th birthday your license automatically becomes a basic license.

Penalties for violations and accidents:

First violation: Passenger and nighttime restrictions will apply until you're 18. DOL will send a warning letter to you and your parent/guardian for the following:

- Get a ticket for violating the restrictions.
- Get a ticket for violating a rule of the road.
- Are involved in an accident where:
 - You get a ticket or are determined to have caused the accident.
 - No one involved in the accident receives a ticket.
 - The cause of the accident can't be determined.
 - Only your car was involved in the accident.

2nd violation: License suspended for 6 months (or until you're 18, whichever comes first). DOL will notify you and your parent/guardian before DOL take any suspension action.

3rd violation: License suspended until you're 18. DOL will notify you and your parent/guardian before DOL take any suspension action.

Program Requirements

Instruction Permit: All students must be able to obtain a permit.

Students must have their permits with them at all times. On the first day of class an Instruction Permit Application will be given to students which will allow them to get a permit without taking a written test. Permits are issued by the Department of Licensing – the fee is \$25. To obtain a permit the student and a custodial parent or guardian take the completed application, proof of the student's age, parental relationship (original of birth certificate), a photo ID and the \$25 fee to a DOL office. Students must pass an eye examination at the DOL before receiving a permit. If there is a potential legal, medical, or vision problem that might prohibit the student from getting a permit, check with DOL before registering for the class.

Attendance

Minimum course duration is 5 weeks and maximum of 26 weeks. Programs are 5 weeks, 30 hours of classroom instruction, 6 hours on-street driving lessons that are one hour each and one hour observation. Cannot miss more than 3 class lesson, all of which need to be made up, if more than 3 classes are missed, the entire course will have to be taken over.

<u>Refunds</u>

There is a \$25 refund processing fee. Refund requests must be made in second day of class. After third day of class has been completed, there will be no refund. If a class is cancelled due to low enrollment, the full amount will be refunded.

Insurance: Students are covered while driving the Traffic Education cars under the Hong Kong Driving School insurance policy. The insurance policy does not cover students while driving other vehicles. Check with your insurance agent to ensure coverage before the student drives other vehicles.
